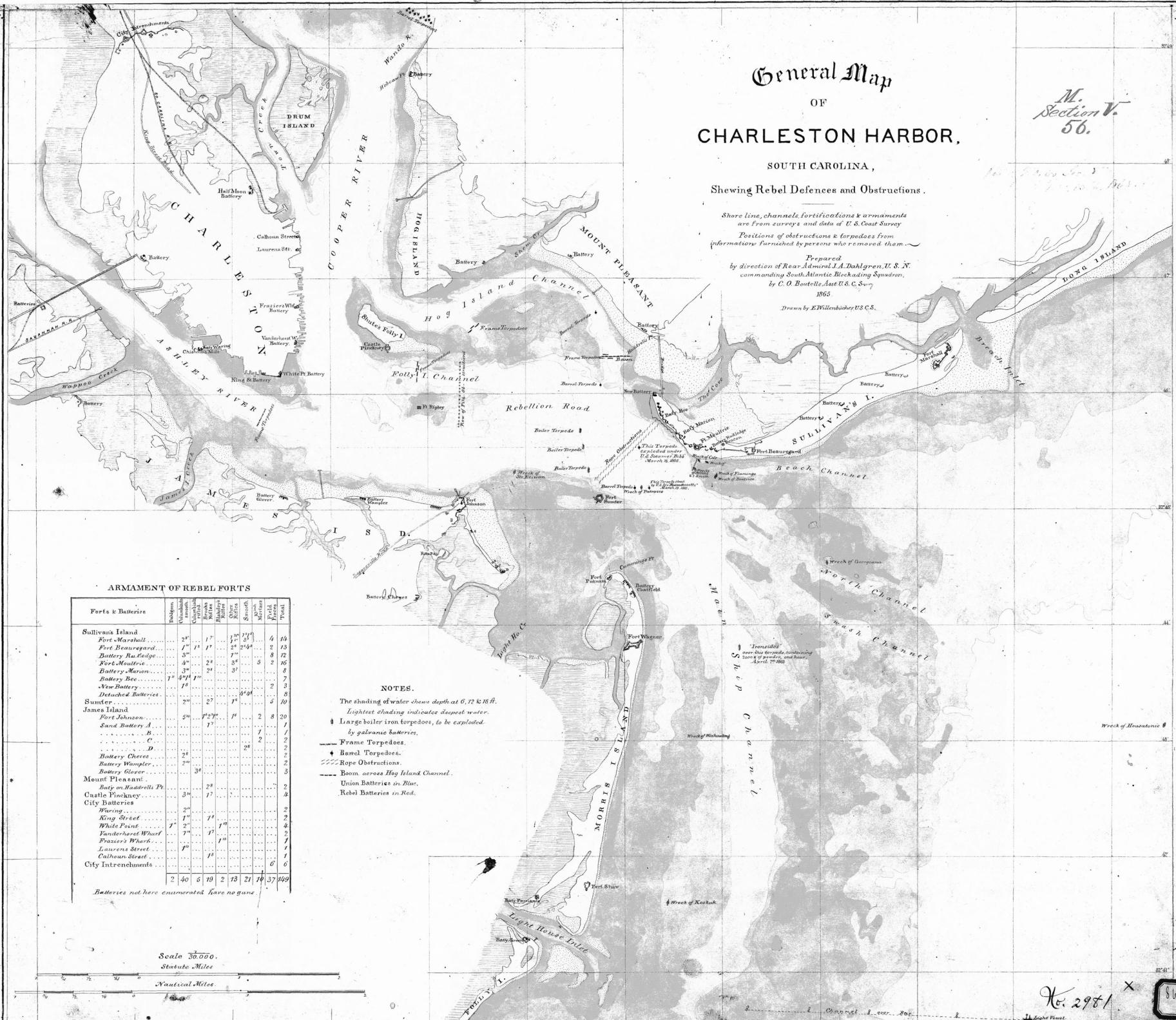


General Map OF CHARLESTON HARBOR,
